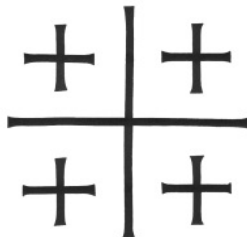

**The Invitation to the Lord’s Table**

**Prayer of Thanksgiving**

L: Lift up your hearts.

**C: We lift them up to the Lord our God.**

L: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

**C: It is right to give God our thanks and praise,  
who is Creator, Redeemer, Sustainer, and Friend.**

*(Here begins the Prayer of Thanksgiving)*

**We Share Together in the Bread and Wine**

*This is a celebration of Christ’s gathered community at which he is the host. As you pass the bread, we invite you to say to your neighbor, “This is the bread of life.” We hold the bread until all are served and then partake together. As you pass the cup, we invite you to say to your neighbor, “This is the cup of blessing.” You may partake of the cup as you receive it.*

**The Thanksgiving after the Supper**

L: Bless the Lord, O my soul:

**C: And all that is within me, bless God’s holy name.**

L: Bless the Lord, O my soul;

**C: And forget not all God’s benefits.**

L: Let us pray together:

**Lead us, O God, in the way of Christ.  
Give us courage to take up our cross  
and, in full reliance upon your grace, to follow him.  
Help us to love you above all else  
and to love our neighbor as we love ourselves,  
demonstrating that love in deed and word  
in the power of your spirit.**
