Isaiah 43: 16-19

Joshua 3: 1-17

When you have more confidence in what you presently have, you have less confidence in the things you hope for.

When you cannot see the invisible you become blind to the visible. Because the invisible you need is on the other side of the visible.

Don't mistake your wilderness with the promised land where God wants you to live.

In the wilderness the children of Israel were lead by fire at night and cloud by day, they had daily manna. Their clothes didn't wear off.

The Promised Land required:

1. Greater obedience to the Lord - they had to step in the river of Jordan by faith, they also had to wait before crossing. They had not passed this way before - they couldn't compare their old miracles with the new things God was doing.
2. Greater responsibility to what was promised to them. They had to take care of the land.
3. Greater level of walking out their God given authority.

Moses and others who declined to change and adopt to the new things God was doing died in the wilderness.

God is doing a new thing - it's up to us to join and be a part of this new season. He is still a miracle working God who is able to part the impossibility ("your Red Sea") and cause you to cross over onto the other side into your Promised Land!
